Bless the City Program

Mark Spengler from "Bless the City" provided an overview of "City of Life Initiative". The goal of the effort is to change Colorado Springs to a Culture of Life by making it an abortion free City. Fr. Bill Carmody reported that he has been trying to facilitate both Protestants and Catholics to work together to create an abortion free city and this is the first time his goal of presenting a common front has been attained. Fr. Bill asked the councils to consider donations to "Bless the City" effort. Bless the City is a registered name of the Center for Law and Social Strategy (CLASS) here in Colorado. Priest in Need

Brother John Garr, KofC Insurance Field Agent, reported that Fr. Alfredo Garcia of Holy Apostles, who was a recent contract priest for Peterson AFB, is caring for his mother who is wheel chair bound. He is in need for help in purchasing a handicapped enabled vehicle. He was recently notified that she will loose Medicaid Funding. Because there are many recent changes happening and many unanswered questions, the Chapter provided many good inputs for Brother John to pursue. John will meet with Fr. Garcia, the Holy Apostles GK and others to better determine what help is needed in the present circumstances and come back with a proposal.

CITY OF LIFE INITIATIVE

Background & Introduction

Colorado Springs probably has more beneficial global impact in terms of blessing the poor, orphans, and touching the spiritually blind than any other American city of similar population. Yet its social conditions reflect severely high suicide rates, homelessness, and property and violent crime rates 50% above the state average. This is inconsistent with the blessing of God. He desires a generation of His followers to seek the welfare of the city with new eyes and actions that dramatically transform the culture to reflect His goodness. The City of Life Initiative is the first phase of a broader strategy called "Bless the City", a mobilization of faith communities with goals and objectives resulting in cultural transformation.

Overview

The Colorado Springs City of Life Initiative (CLI) began with the Strategy III workshop conducted at Glen Eyrie October 25-26, 2013. This workshop brought together local and national pro-life individuals and organizations facilitated by the Sanctity of Life Foundation. The results of this workshop are the foundation for the goals that the Initiative has set for itself in Colorado Springs.

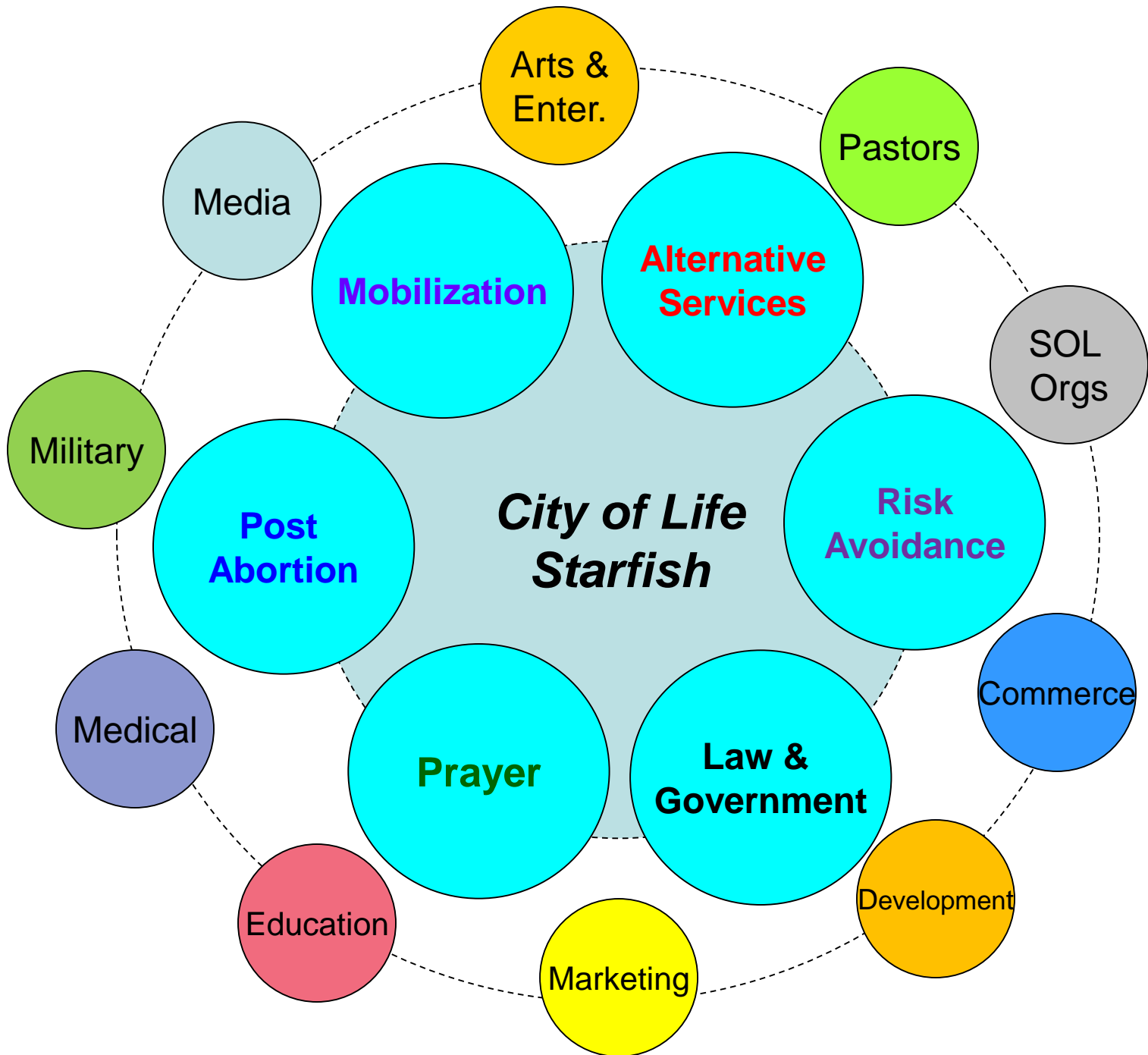
The Vision
