Supreme Form and Vocations Report

Worthy State Officers, DDs, and Brother Knights

Supreme Forms

We are coming to the end of the fraternal year for Supreme Forms, 185, 365, 1295, 1728 and Sp-7.

SP-7 is due June 30th, if you have not turned in your SP-7 to State Program Director as of Feb1st, please start thinking about getting that filled out and sent in. Even if you have not completed five programs in each of the six areas, go ahead and submit the form to Supreme. SP-7 filled out completely makes you eligible for Star Council.

Elections are coming up next month, no later than June 15th. This will be the time to start filling out Form 185 Report of Officer Chosen, this form will be turned in by June 30th, and Form 365 Service Program Personnel Report turned in by August 15th. Make sure outgoing GKs brief newly elected GKs prior to leaving office.

I already have access to Supreme forms web site, and will be monitoring it very closely this year. I will be submitting my report at Organizational meeting for SP-7 and Form 185 on those Councils that have not turned in their reports.

Vocations

I want to thank all of the Chapter Councils for supporting out Seminarians and Postulants here in Colorado Springs, Denver and Pueblo Diocese

We will have Priestly Ordination on June 7th, St. Mary's Cathedral at 10am for Brother Knights Deacon Michael Buckley and SK Deacon John Stearns.

There were 54 Colorado State Councils participating in the RSVP Program for 2012-2013.

Donations totaled \$91,000 dollars, Refunds of \$18,100 dollars, 149 Male Awardees and 7 Female awardees.

We are coming to the end of another school year for all Seminarians and Postulants. New Men and Women will be interviewed and approved for their Vocation to the Priesthood and Novitiate programs to start in August and September 2014. The Vocations Committee will receive new listing starting in the middle of September. Just as soon as we get the list, I will be sending word to via DDs and the committee will start updating our web site for non supported Seminarians and Postulants.
