Welcome brother Knights.

Yesterday was Latarie Sunday. Latarie in Latin mean REJOICE. You may have noticed the Rose Colored vestments at Mass. We are half way through Lent and we are rejoicing because Easter is not far away. If you are anything like me, you have already broken whatever your Lenten Sacrifice has been. But it is never too late to start afresh and refocus your attention on the last 3 weeks of Lent.

Yesterday was also March 19, typically the feast of St Joseph. But because March 19 was on Sunday, we celebrate the Feast of St Joseph today.

St. Joseph has two feast days on the liturgical calendar. The first is today; the Feast of St Joseph, the Husband of Mary. The second is May 1; the Feast of St Joseph, the Worker.

There is very little about the life of Joseph in Scripture but still, we know that he was the chaste husband of Mary, the foster father of Jesus, a carpenter and a man who was not wealthy. We also know that he came from the royal lineage of King David.
